

WHEREAS, On the 8th day of November, 2022, an election was held in the State of Illinois at which time the addition of Section 25 to Article I of the Illinois Constitution was submitted, and

WHEREAS, In pursuance of Law, the State of Board of Elections appointed to canvass the returns of such election and to declare the results thereof, did, on this, the 5th day of December, 2022, canvass the same, and as a result of such canvass, did declare that the Proposed Amendment to the Illinois Constitution has received either three-fifths of those voting on the question or a majority of those voting in the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JB Pritzker, Governor of the State of Illinois, in conformity to statute in such case made and provided, do hereby make public proclamation, declaring as a result of such canvass the foregoing results.
